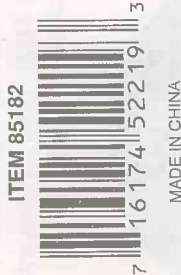




Project Ideas & Instructions

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BRAIDING TOOL INSTRUCTIONS

For every 1 1/2" of braiding you will need approximately 1 yard of Nooodles™.

Pull Nooodles™ through hole in braiding tool, top to bottom, leave approximately 4" of Nooodles™ from bottom. (see figure 1)

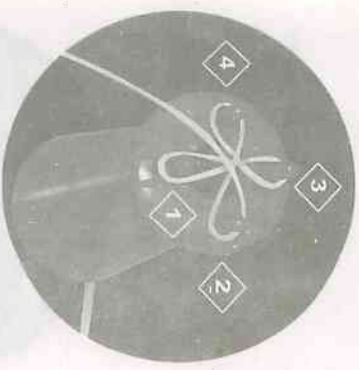

Holding Braider with Peg 1 directly in front of you, pass working end of Nooodles™ around Peg 1 from left to right. (see figure 1)

Loop Nooodles™ around Peg 3 opposite Peg 1, from left to right. (see figure 1)

Bring Nooodles™ around Peg 4, bottom to top and then around Peg 2, bottom to top, (see figure 1).

Bring Nooodles™ around to left side of Peg 1. Now you are ready to braid.

Hold Braiding Tool with left hand and needle with right hand, pass Nooodles™ around Peg 1 from left to right (in front), (see figure 2). Pick up bottom stitch with needle and slip it over Peg 1 (see figure 3 & 4).

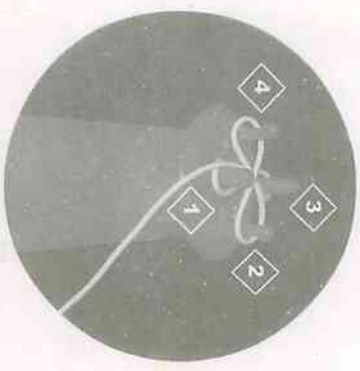

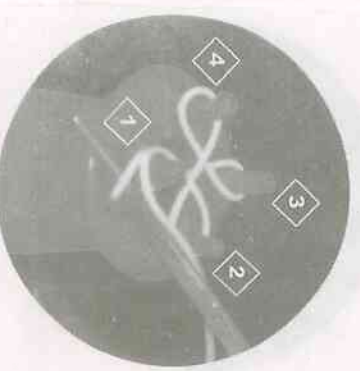

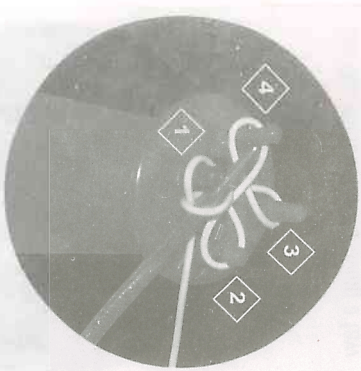

Go to Peg 2, pass Nooodles™ from left to right (in front), pick up bottom stitch and slip over Peg 3. Go to Peg 3, and do the same. Go to Peg 4 and do the same. ** (repeating figures 3 & 4).

Repeat steps 2 through 6 until you have the desired length or braid, turning tool as you go from peg to peg. (see figure 5)

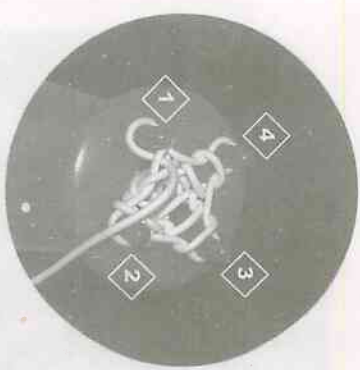

A gentle pull on Nooodles™ end and a gentle push in center hole, will help to keep stitches even.

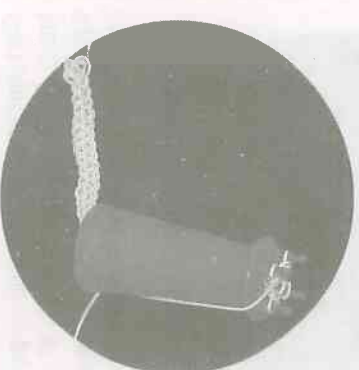

The braided section gradually comes through the bottom of the Braiding Tool. (see figure 6) Continue braiding until you have reached desired length.

TO FINISH: Hold Braiding Tool with Peg 1 directly in front of you. Keep the working end of Nooodles™ in back of the Peg you will be taking off (see figure 7).

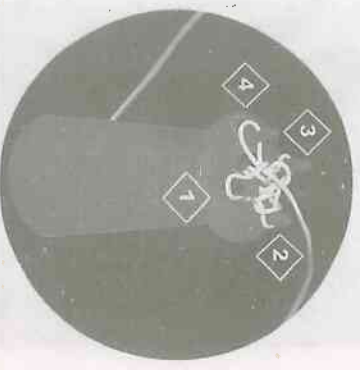

Take stitch off Peg 1 and place it on the Peg 4. (see figure 8). You will have two stitches on Peg 4.

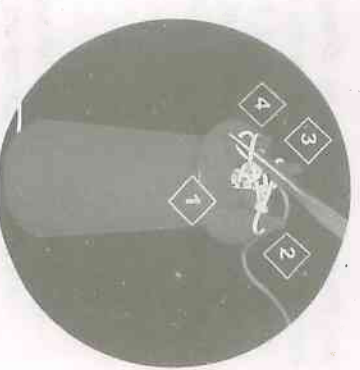
