

Pull the bottom stitch over top. (see figure 9)

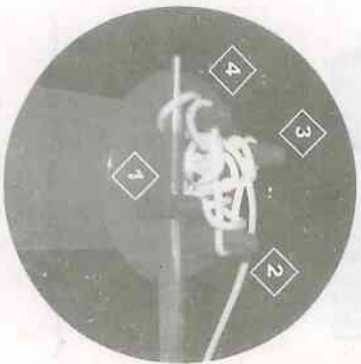

Take stitch off Peg 4 and put on Peg 3 (see figure 10). Pull bottom stitch over top. (see figure 11).

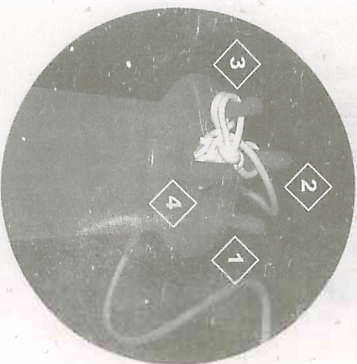

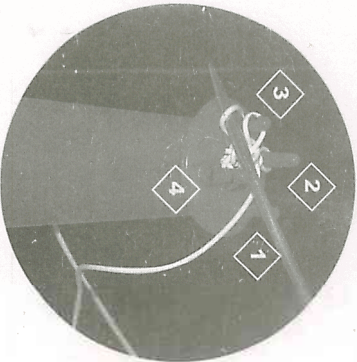

Take stitch off Peg 3 and put on Peg 2 (see figure 12). Pull bottom stitch over top. (see figure 13)

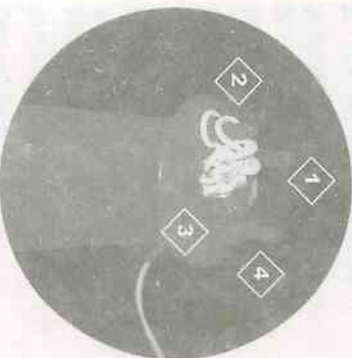

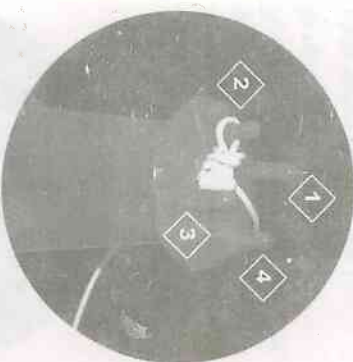

One stitch remains on Peg 2. (see figure 13)

Slip last loop gently off Peg and insert working end of Noooodles™ through loop and draw tight (see figure 14)

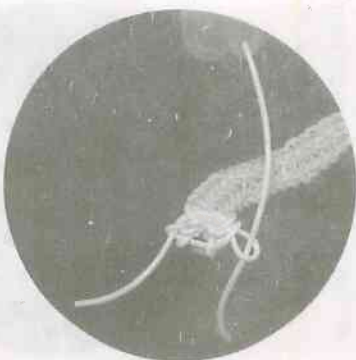

Cut the Noooodles™ leaving a few inches (see figure 15)

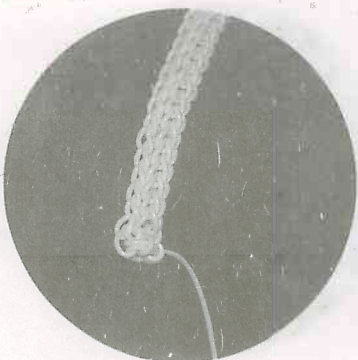

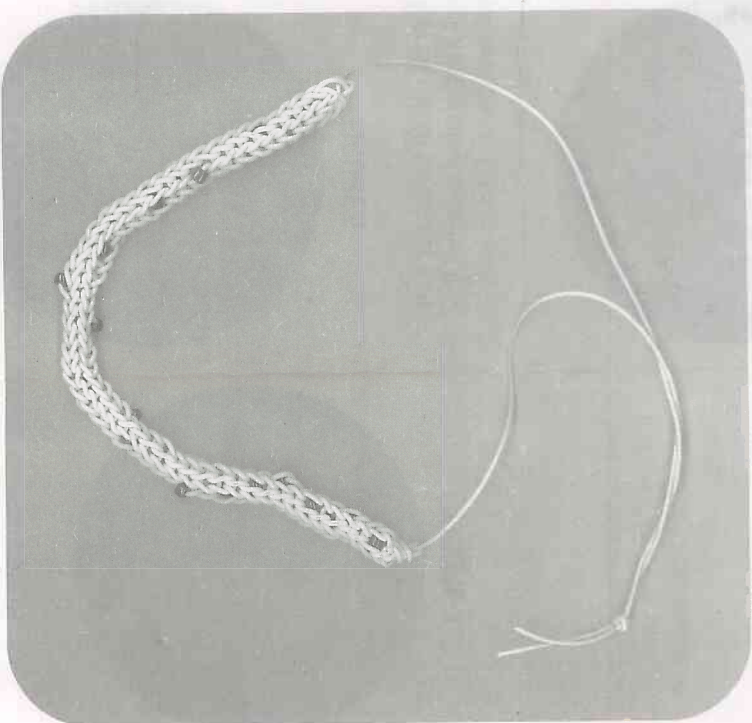
\*\*You can do right to left or left to right, just remain consistent throughout.

### PROJECT IDEAS:

You can make "Pet Leashes", Bracelets, Chokers, Belts, Jump Ropes, Hair Scrunchie Embellishments and many more fun things. Just make your braid to desired length and knot at ends. You can also add beads as you are braiding to enhance your project. You can add lanyard hooks and jewelry findings to ends of braids for closures.

### NECKLACE:

Approx. 5 yards of Noooodles™ and approx. 24 "E" beads. Instead of leaving 4" at the beginning in Step 1, leave 8". String the "E" beads on all at once. Start your braiding and randomly put one "E" on in between the pegs as you braid. Finish with approximately 8" after you do your casting off. Tie to make a necklace. You can pull the "E" beads through the braid so you can see them better or you can leave them as they are.



### BRACELET:

Same as above but leave 4"
